

Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is my pleasure to report on the working of the Czech and Slovak Club Tauranga and to give you an overview of our club activities over the past 12 months.

First of all I would like to begin with a few numbers. Ninety-five, thirty, ten, six, five, one.

Ninety five. Stands for the number of registered members in the club including the children in our school. Most of our members come from the area of Bay of Plenty and Waikato. However, with the increasing appeal of our events and activities we do have members from further afield in NZ. There are no restrictions on who can join the club, as long as you find our efforts entertaining, educational and they enhance the value our community provides to you or your family, feel free to come along and join us.

Thirty. Is a number of events that our club organised or co-produced in FY 2017/2018. Every single one of these required a degree of involvement from members of our Organising Team and at times from other members of the club. Big thanks goes to those who helped out.

Year 2017 was quite a special year in the history of the club. It marked the **five** year anniversary since the inception of our Czech School, which gave the rise to the club itself. We marked this anniversary with dinner for the founding members and General Consul Hana Flanderova a guest from MZV Sydney. The festive spirit continued to school celebrations, where our school children performed a dance routine and everyone joined in a song called "Holky, kluci přidejte se!", written specially for the anniversary. Even the obligatory cake, in the shape of a school bag, see pics on Facebook, was enjoyed by all.

The proof that life in the club is far from boring is illustrated in the children book "Annie and Johnny's diary: A year in New Zealand". This unique project and certainly a club first, came about as an idea at the Czech school conference held in Tauranga in May 2017. On the one hand, it was our desire to create a legacy for our school /club activities for years to come and on the other to spread enthusiasm amongst our existing members and new immigrants to join in our community.

In July 2017 we welcomed a visiting czech teacher PhDr. Jiri Kostecka PhD to join us for a week



of intensive classes aimed at the children of our school. This took place in a home location and was attended by about ten children. This fantastic opportunity was a result of our cooperation with DZS (Dům Zahraniční Spolupráce) in Prague. Mr Kostecka is a professor of bilingual education and a top educator in the area. The classes were so highly praised by children and adults alike that we have agreed to repeat it in 2018. This time we decided to extend it to a much larger audience and attendees from across New Zealand. The Czech and Slovak language camp took place in April 2018.

In 2018 we passed on the batten to our friends in Dunedin to organise the mainstay of our event calendar, the Czech and Slovak Summer Camp. Whilst helping with the initial administrative setup the main onus was on Martin Dvoracek and his team, who did a great job with the organisation. Well done and thank you! Summer Camp 2019 will once again return to the North Island and will be a shared event between teams in Tauranga and Czech School Auckland.

Last event I would like to highlight is the Multicultural Festival. I am proud to say that it was again better than ever. We loved watching our little and adult performers on the stage. There was a wonderful dancing couple who performed the Polka to the cheering crowd. We even got the audience to join in singing "Hlava, ramena" that we sung in slovakian language. I was particularly emotional listening to five-year old Nina Smith's perfect rendition of "Dělání, dělání". Next year, it will be 20th anniversary of Multicultural festival and I know that our teachers and club members have something special in store. As you can imagine, event organising is a gargantuan task if attempted by just a handful of people. But as the saying goes: "Many hands make light work", I would like to encourage you to step up and offer a hand in getting things off the ground.
