We had 6 families (10 children 6 and under) attending those evenings regularly and a couple more occasionally.

I can not disregard how big an impact learning Czech language has on home learning. If it is done by application Vcelka, through regular magazines or various books, or online classes. All of that was ordered, organized and paid by the Czech Club.
